

"Anything Strange?"

is the debut album of **Kerbside**, the talented husband and wife team of Seán and Kim Lightholder.

Combining Seán's haunting lyrics and Kim's outstanding voice, *Anything Strange?* is a mixture of acoustic pop and a few deeper, darker offerings like "Talk". **Hotpress magazine** describes it as,

Since the album's release, **Kerbside** has been featured live on radio programmes in Dublin, Cork, Mullingar and Galway and have racked up many hours of performance at innumerable venues and showcases throughout Ireland, as well as in the UK at the 2005 **Cambridge Folk Festival** (the band has since been invited back to play at the Cambridge Folk Club's November and March showcase events).

Although seasoned artists entertaining in the Midlands area, this is the first time the pair has ventured into performing just their own original music.

And the duo has already been a hit with the critics.

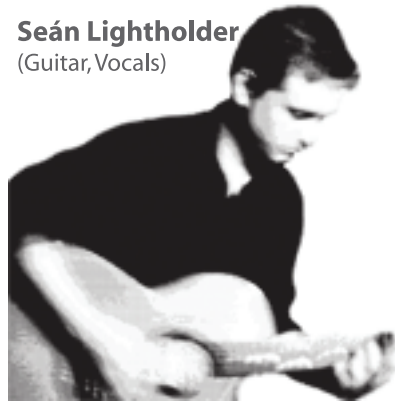

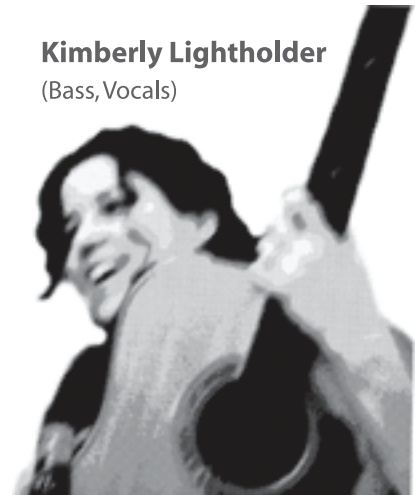


The Lightholders, who originally hail from the San Francisco Bay Area, arrived in Ireland three years ago.
